Does Camp provide additional towels and/or blankets throughout our stay?

Sorry, we do not provide additional towels and/or blankets throughout your stay.

Does Camp clean throughout our stay?

Sorry, we do not provide housekeeping throughout your stay.

Who do we call if there is an emergency?

Are there any hikes we can take during our stay?

All of our hikes are guided. Please call prior to your reservation to book. Hikes require a minimum of 10 people.

Do we have use of the golf carts?

Use of the golf cart is reserved for camp staff only. We are happy to assist you!

Are there bugs at camp?

We are a rustic campground in the mountains so there are some bugs. You can prepare by bringing mosquito repellent.

Does it get cold at night?

It can get cold at night, especially in the winter months. Please pack accordingly.

What are the gate hours?

Gate hours are open from 8 am – 10 pm.

Are pets allowed?

Sorry, pets are not allowed at camp.

Is there drinking water in Hale Mahaholokai?

We use a water catchment tank for the showers, sink & toilet. We provide two 5-gallon water jugs for drinking. If you require additional drinking water, you are welcome to bring your jugs to camp to fill up in the mess hall.

Do you provide air mattresses?

Yes, for an additional \$10 per mattress, we can provide your party with up to 3 air mattresses with sheets (blanket not provided).

What is there to do once we get to camp?

All of our activities are al la carte. Please call prior to your reservation to book.

Are there outlets in the bunkhouses?

Yes

Is there Wifi at Camp?

There is no Wifi at camp, however you are welcome to rent a Wifi jet pack. Please call the camps office to add this to your reservation.

Are kids free?

Kids aged 3 and under are free of charge.

Is there a day fee for guests joining for the day?

Yes, there is a \$5 fee per day guest.
